In the spring of 1956 the Central Illinois District Board of Directors issued a call to Rev. Carl Geiger of Mattoon, Illinois, Chairman of the District Mission Board. Upon his acceptance he was installed as Missionary-at-Large in the Macomb area by Rev. E.M. Goltermann of Quincy on Sunday, June 17, 1956, in the McArthur School Auditorium.
